
Rapley Lake

This final section is best visited between the end of April and mid-May. The area is quite wet and boggy, but at this time of year there is a thick carpet of Bluebells in the wood alongside Bagshot Park and is well worth investigating. At other times of year, it is only really worth running round if it has been very dry; the area takes weeks to dry out after any significant rainfall. An exception to this is Mill Pond; there is a nice trail round the back of it. There is also a track heading down from Bracknell Road which leads towards Rapley Lake. In wetter conditions, after passing the lake you can circle round to the right and right again to avoid the worst of the mud.
